San Diego Needs You!

SDSU's Active Transportation Research (ATR) is seeking volunteers to assist in bicycle and pedestrian data collection to support active transportation planning in San Diego.

ATR is currently collecting continuous daily bicycle and pedestrian counts in 26 locations across the San Diego region via automated count equipment just installed at the end of Sept 2012. This is the largest network of automated counters in any region in the nation!

We need volunteers to verify the accuracy of our automated counting equipment through field tallies of bicyclists and pedestrians. No previous experience is needed to help with the data collection and training will be provided on the day of the event.

Each visit is anticipated to last approximately 3 hours. The deadline to register is **Friday, November 9th**. This is a great opportunity to support healthy living and sustainable planning policy in San Diego!

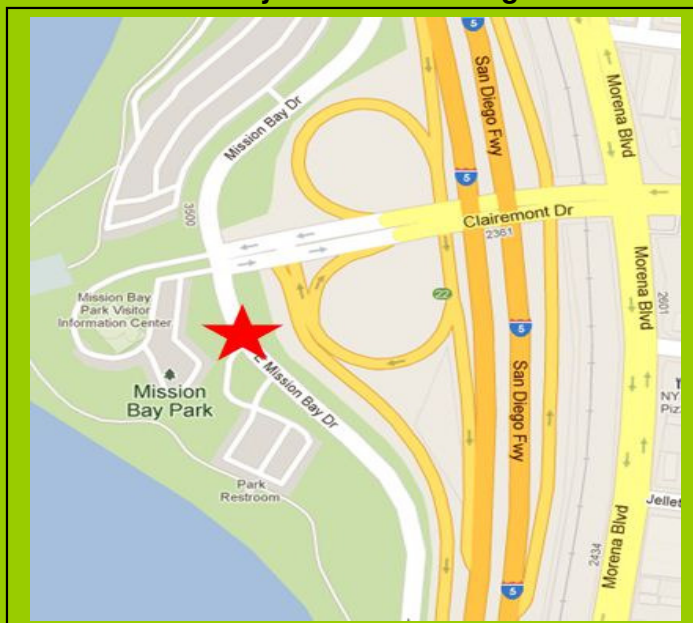

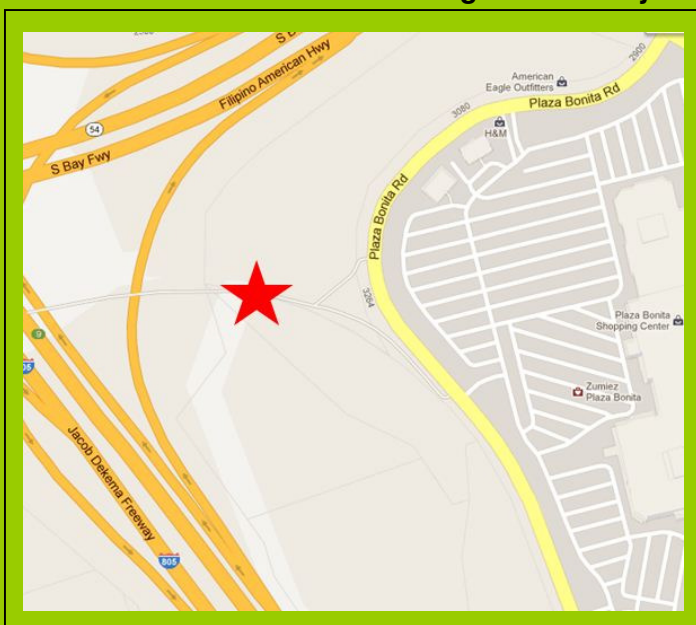
